2010 SELECTION & GRADING POLICY

Definitions

Returning Player: An All Age Player who played with BDSC the previous year or a Junior player who played with BDSC the previous year and has nominated to play in the current year in the next sequential age group from the previous year. A player who was previously a Returning Underage player becomes a Returning Player once they are selected into their nominated age group.

Returning Underage Player: A player who played with BDSC the previous year and has nominated to play in the current year in a lower age group than the next sequential age group from the previous year. A Player only becomes a Returning Underage player if they nominate for an age group lower than the next sequential age group from the previous year.

New Player: A player who did not play with BDSC the previous year or a Returning or Returning Underage player who did not register on or prior to the official registration days.

Selection & Grading Policy

- 1. The general principal (with the specific exception of division 1 teams) of priority for selection in a team/age group will be based on the following order
 - 1st: Returning Players
 - 2nd: Returning Underage Players
 - 3rd: New Players
- 2. Players will nominate & register for 1 particular age group at the time of registration.
- 3. Players will NOT nominate for specific divisions in an age group.
- 4. Players may nominate for an age group 2 age groups higher than their natural age group however this becomes their age group for the year.
- 5. Players register & pay fees knowing that they will be placed in teams at clubs discretion
- 6. Players are to play in most suitable division for their nominated age group.
- 7. In any circumstance where more players have registered than can be accommodated in an age group a competitive grading process will be undertaken in accordance with Pt 1 of this policy until the team/teams in that age group are filled.
- 8. Where a team is playing in Division 1 (one) no less than 11 (eleven) Returning Players will be selected in the team where more than 11 Returning Players & more than 14 players overall have nominated to play in that age division. All players nominating for that age group will undergo a competitive grading process in accordance with Pt 1 of this policy until the team/teams in that age group are filled.
- 9. Where more than 1 team exists within an age group all team selection/grading will result from this years grading (no incumbency from previous years)
- 10. Players unavailable for grading will be placed in whatever team in whichever age divisions as decided by the management committee.
- 11. Maximum players per team squad will be as per clubs by-laws & management committee discretion
- 12. Grading conducted over 1 or 2 nights as required

- 13. Grading conducted by at least 3 assessors including 1 committee representative & 2 "independent" assessors (independence from club is preferred however clear independence from team is sufficient) Input may be sought from the team coach.
- 14. Grading comprises assessment of players
 - Physical Skill
 - Mental Attitude
 - Fitness
 - Football Maturity

The management committee will apportion a scaling system against the individual assessment criteria.

- 15. The club may select more players into a lower division and allow players who develop to migrate to the higher division through the season
- 16. Players who miss the cut into an age group may be offered a place in lower age groups (where possible) or higher age groups (where appropriate).
- 17. All player gradings are subject to review and players may be regraded at any time through the year for reasons as per the policy principals
- 18. Management Committee maintains overriding discretion at all times.
